

**Little Spartan Preschool (4-5 years old)**  
**Full Day Kindergarten Readiness Information**

**Basic Information**

- Each Kindergarten Readiness student must be at least 4 years old by August 1, 2018. Full day kindergarten readiness is not available for 3 year olds.
- If a child is unable to demonstrate age-level skills in the classroom and is not toilet trained, termination from the peer model program could result.
- The Kindergarten Readiness program for all day students will occur Monday through Wednesday from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. ***THURSDAY from 8:00 AM to 2:15 PM*** and ***Friday from 11:45 AM to 3:00PM***
- Kindergarten Readiness follows the Southwestern Consolidated School District of Shelby County school calendar which includes delays and snow days.
- Full day Kindergarten Readiness students may purchase a school lunch (\$2.70 per day) or bring their lunch from home. They will receive a morning and afternoon snack.
- Speech, occupational, and physical therapists may work in the classroom several times per week. Your child may be asked to participate in these activities.
- Kindergarten Readiness students are ***NOT*** given the option to ride a school bus to and from school unless the student has a disability and transportation is specified in the IEP. (Note, this transportation would only be available for the AM.)
- The option exists to participate in the before and after school C.A.R.E. Club from 6:00 AM to 6:00 P.M. and C.A.R.E. Club fees would apply.
- Regular attendance is required for the entire school year. Failure to have good attendance may result in termination from the program. Please notify the school when your child is sick or absent. Doctor's notes will be necessary when appropriate.
- Kindergarten Readiness students should be fully toilet trained during the daytime by the first day of class.
- Parents will receive information on their child's overall classroom performance 4 times per school year.
- Spots for the preschool program will be filled in the order the school receives completed applications with required deposits.
- Students who live within the Southwestern Consolidated School District of Shelby County and staff members' students will be accepted into the program prior to students living outside of the school's district. If there are remaining spots available, they will be open to students who do not live within the school district pending administrative

approval. Due to the limited enrollment, parents are encouraged to apply as soon as registration opens to ensure a spot for their preschooler.

### **Fees and Application**

- Parents of prospective Kindergarten Readiness students must complete and submit all components of the Kindergarten Readiness Program Registration Packet to the school office prior to beginning the program. Components which are to be submitted are the following:
  - Application
  - One month's non-refundable deposit (\$300.00)
  - Registration Form
  - Child's Birth Certificate
  - Child's Immunization Record
- Applications will be distributed and/or posted on the school webpage and in the school's office.
- All day Kindergarten Readiness Program fees are \$300.00 per month due the fifteenth day of each month beginning in July. Non-payment of monthly fees in a timely manner may result in the child's termination from the preschool program.
- The \$300.00 deposit will apply to the last monthly (May) fee of the current school year if the student has attended the program all year and all monthly fees are paid in a timely manner. The \$300.00 deposit, otherwise, is non-refundable.
- The assessment team will make the final decision as to your child attending the Kindergarten Readiness Program. The decision will be based on a variety of areas including your child's demonstrated skills during a screening process.
- Parents will be notified of acceptance after the preschool screenings have been completed.

### **Dates and Times**

- Kindergarten Readiness Program will be offered Mondays, Tuesday, Wednesdays, and Thursdays and Fridays between the months of August to May.
- Each day, class will begin at 8:00 AM and end at 3:00 PM. ***Thursdays will be from 8:00 AM and end at 2:15 PM and Fridays from 11:45 AM to 3:00PM***
- Kindergarten Readiness Program will follow the Southwestern Consolidated School District's calendar and observance of breaks (Fall Break, Winter Break, Spring Break) and holidays ( i.e. Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Martin Luther King Day, and etc.).
- The Kindergarten Readiness Program will follow the Southwestern Consolidated School District's snow make up days.
